DISCIPLINE

So let’s strive to be at alert as it concerns our learners. As parents, if we work in synergy with the school, normalization will therefore be inevitable in our adolescents who at this stage may display behaviours like disobedience (putting on wrong or mutilated uniforms, etc.), irresponsibility (not doing their assignments on and offline, not updating note) and finally not knowing their boundaries thereby infringing on other learners’ freedom. Every student is free here but their freedom has limits/boundaries. We must collectively train them to respect boundaries.

PUNCTUALITY TO SCHOOL

This is to remind you, our esteemed parents, that resumption to school remains 7:40am Monday – Friday. The school frowns at lateness as it is compulsory for all students to participate in the morning assembly which begins at 7:50am. Punctuality is a virtue that we need to imbibe in our students as this will be a great asset to them in future, in leadership and in life. Hence, parents/guardians should endeavour to pick up their ward(s) from school on time. School closes at 3:00pm (Monday- Thursday) and 1:00pm (on Friday). Beyond 3:30pm on Monday –Thursday and 1:30pm on Friday, a fine of #2,000 will apply. School community development will be meted out to latecomers.

SECURITY CONSCIOUSNESS

We are aware of the security situation around us. Parents should be security conscious at all times.
